SCHOOL RULES



- Students are expected to move safely and quietly in all areas of the school
- Students are not allowed to leave the school grounds without the permission of the Principal, or Deputy Principal or his/her teacher or Year Adviser. Students must report to the office and sign out before leaving the grounds. If a student has an appointment they are also asked to sign out and sign back in at the office on their return.
- Students are not allowed to use mobile phones at all during class time, this also applies to iPods, etc.
- Students are expected to wear the correct school uniform at all times.
- Students may enter school buildings during recess or lunch only with the permission of a teacher.
- Kindergarten to Year 2 students may play on the fixed equipment only under teacher supervision at lunchtime.
- Students are expected to behave in a positive and friendly manner to all members of the school community. The respect of people and property is encouraged and expected.
- Students are expected to use common sense and follow all other directions issued by teachers and staff.
- No level of drug use is acceptable in our school. Anyone in possession of a prohibited drug will be immediately suspended and reported to their parents and police.

PLAYGROUND ACTIVITIES

- Lunch – First 10 minutes Kinder to Yr6 students must sit in the shaded area.
- Wet Weather – During wet weather all students must go to their allocated classrooms. Secondary students go to Rooms 20 and 21. Primary and Infants students go to their own classrooms.
- Sun safe Policy – children must wear a school hats at all times when outdoors.

SAFETY

- Children will climb on and off equipment safely.
- All common sense and safe behaviour is expected eg. Sharing, consideration, no pushing, fighting or bullying.
- Avoid overcrowding of equipment.
- The riding of motor bikes, push bikes and skate boards in the school grounds is not permitted.
